- Theory and concepts of the articular tissue adjustment. The different methods to do an articular tissue adjustment
 - Tissue tests: lumbar, sacral, thoracic and cervical
 - General position of osteopathic manipulation for lumbar area – first treat L5
 - Discussion about osteopathic cervical manipulations
 - General position of osteopathic manipulation for cervical area – first treat C5
 - General position of osteopathic manipulation for thoracic area – first treat middle thoracic
 - Exercises to treat with impulse
